The Position

Reporting to the Board of Education and supported by a financial and facilities team, the Superintendent is responsible for the overall leadership and the lead on the cycle of Enhancing Student Learning, implementing the requirements of the School Act, hiring, organizing, administering, supervising, and evaluating all educational programs. Working with a highly collaborative and collegial school district, the Superintendent engages with two First Nations.

The Candidate

The Board of Education is seeking a strong, proactive education leader with integrity, who values early learning, is student-focused and enjoys the opportunities and challenges of rural education. The ability to build and enhance relationships is vital to continue the strong collegial work in the district. Furthering the current Enhancing Student Learning Plan for the District and schools with a focus on Early Learning, Literacy, Numeracy, Social and Emotional Learning, and Career Development/Graduation Goals is a key requisite as it focuses on continuing our District's strength in Reading, Graduation Rates, and maintaining the achievement of our indigenous and non-indigenous students. Excellent team building and communication skills and a CEO who will work with the Board in an open and trusting environment are essential. The ability to manage personal stress, and be a calm, respectful, and supportive leader is required.

The ideal candidate will possess proven leadership experience, including at the primary and/or elementary experience.
