Our District

The North Vancouver School District is situated upon the unceded traditional territory of the Sḵwx̱wú7mesh (Squamish) Nation and sə́ilwə́taʔl (Tsleil-Waututh) Nation. The school district provides world-class instruction and a rich diversity of engaging programs across 25 elementary schools and seven secondary schools to inspire success for every student and bring communities together to learn, share and grow. With 16,000 students, their parents and guardians, and more than 2,500 staff, with an annual budget that exceeds \$206 million, there is a strong sense of community across the district.

The Role

Reporting to the Secretary-Treasurer, the Director of Financial Services provides leadership and direction for the stewardship of school district finances and assets. The Director of Finance is responsible for the efficient operation of the district's financial, accounting, purchasing and payroll services, and ensures timely, accurate and consistent financial reporting and analysis.
